37 City and Other Government Councils Endorse U.S. Department of Peace Legislation

Thirty-three city councils/commissions, including Los Angeles, Chicago, Atlanta and Detroit, plus three county boards of supervisors and one tribal council have passed resolutions endorsing legislation to establish a U.S. Department of Peace. All told, these local governing bodies represent populations of more than 12.5 million people.
